**DAAD Prize 2019 for International RWTH Students**

Dear Sir or Madam

The DAAD Prize awards academically excellent international students and PhD candidates for their social and intercultural engagement. RWTH Aachen University faculties, university organizations, RWTH student associations and the student union AStA can nominate international students and PhD students for the 2019 DAAD Award **who have particularly excelled academically and are also socially or interculturally active**. The award amounts to **€ 1,000**.

International students and PhD students who are advanced in their studies (Bachelor: at least 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, Master: at least 2<sup>nd</sup> semester) or have recently completed their studies (in the last three months) or are completing their doctoral studies at RWTH Aachen University can be nominated. The nominees should primarily live in Germany, show good academic achievements and be socially and interculturally active. Students cannot apply for the prize themselves; they have to be nominated by the institutions mentioned above.

The prize is open to so-called "Bildungsausländer". These are students who have acquired their higher education entrance qualification at a (German) school abroad or who have supplemented school qualifications acquired abroad with a German Studienkolleg. Exchange students and students who have acquired a German university entrance qualification (Bildungsinländer) or students who have already received the DAAD Award **cannot** be considered.

Please send your nominations via email to the International Office, Ms. Dominika Dudzik by **June 11, 2019, including a curriculum vitae and a description of the outlining academic** (current performance record) **and social and / or intercultural extracurricular achievements** (Phone: 80- 90833, email: [dominika.dudzik@zhv.rwth-aachen.de](mailto:dominika.dudzik@zhv.rwth-aachen.de)).

A selection committee will review the nominations and determine the winner. The prize will be awarded during the RWTH Welcome Week in September 2019.
