1) Call for Co-Trainers in the frame of our intercultural trainings for international students (Component of the <u>Certificate International</u>)

Then signing up as a Co-Trainer is the right thing for you!

Being a co-trainer in an intercultural training course includes the organizational and content-related support of the trainer in an intercultural training course for international students.

These are usually English training workshops for international students at the beginning of the semester with the focus on intercultural communication, the German university system, different cultural standards, Do's and Don'ts in Germany, etc. – basically everything what is of interest to our new international freshmen at RWTH Aachen. Being a co-trainer will be also considered as a component for the Certificate International at RWTH.

Diversity and openness to all people are a matter of course for them.

In the past year 2023, around 40 percent of all dishes sold in the canteens at RWTH Aachen University were already meat-free. "And anyone who still wants to eat meat can go to Mensa Academica, for example," says the Studierendenwerk. The "Veggie-Mensa" will be open on weekdays from 10:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Friday until 2:30 p.m.).
