The outstanding is currently active as a "buddy" in our BeBuddy program, a role in which he supports newly enrolled international students with settling into university life. He also worked for AEGEE Aachen as a tutor and as a member of UNICEF Aachen, he organized fundraising campaigns for children in need. 2020 he co-founded NeuroTX Aachen. NeuroTX Aachen does amazing stuff with brain signal processing and its translation into real-world practical engineering applications such as brain-computer interface.
