The Student Advice Centre would like to support you with longer-term coaching to help you get settled back into your studies. This coaching is based on your individual needs, which are clarified with you at the beginning. Your coach will regularly held short backup meetings throughout the semester with you so you will have a continued guidance and a final meeting at the end of the semester. Together with you, your coach will establish a strategy, draw up a realistic plan of action, and support you in implementing it.
