# 1) Support the Go Abroad Fair at RWTH Aachen!

Every year, the International Office hosts the **Go Abroad Fair**, an information and networking fair for students on the topics of studying, internships and research abroad. This year it will take place on **Monday, October 23, from 2 to 5 pm, in Super C, 6**<sup>th</sup> floor.

On the <u>Go Abroad Fair</u>, many RWTH institutions such as the International Office, the Faculties and the Language Center as well as interesting external organizations offer information and consultation about going abroad. The fair is part of the <u>Go Abroad Week</u>, a framework program of numerous information and advisory events, which takes place throughout the week of October 23 to 27, 2023.

Due to the size of the Go Abroad Fair (usually around 800 students) as well as the other events of the Go Abroad Week, we are in need of student volunteers to assist! Of course, volunteering – when it's <u>at</u> <u>least five hours</u> - can get recognized as a component of the <u>RWTH Certificate International</u>.
