1) Register now for the Workshop on Intercultural Communication – Sept 8-9, 2022

Working in international teams requires intercultural competence, awareness and solution finding in possible conflict situations. During the two days seminar, students are given the opportunity to develop their intercultural competence; a skillset which becomes ever more useful for all professional activities and which is thus looked for by prospective employers. As the seminar is held in English, you will also improve your English language proficiency. Therefore, you should bring a basic knowledge of English so as to be able to participate in discussions and group activities. At the end, you will receive a certificate of participation. Attendance on all two days is required.

The workshop is free of charge and is held by Alexia Petersen. Ms. Petersen is a highly experienced trainer and consultant in intercultural communication, working with various target groups in both universities and research institutions, and international companies.

4) Important changes from the Immigration Office at Super C

We would like to inform you about some important news from the SuperC Branch Office of the Immigration Office for the StädteRegion Aachen. The new online appointment tool of the Immigration Office allows you to book an appointment yourself and independently. If in urgent cases (e.g. a residence permit has already expired or is about to expire) no appointment is available in the appointment tool, please contact the new information desk of the Immigration Office in SuperC foyer.

Please be aware that if you have changed residence within Germany and were previously registered in a different German city before moving to Aachen, that the main branch of the



Immigration Office next to the central train station is responsible for the first issue/extension of your residence permit in Aachen.

The **new information desk** of the Immigration Office is now open for visitors in SuperC foyer intermittently during office hours. There will soon be a letterbox at the desk, which you can use to submit applications. Please bring your residence permit and additionally your passport to every visit to the Immigration Office besides the usual required applications and documents and apply for an extension about 3 months before expiration. Please always provide the following important information to the Foreigners' Office in case of email inquiries: First name, last name, date of birth, nationality.

The International Office of RWTH Aachen is pleased about this new service and information desk from the Immigration Office and welcomes the new team in SuperC. A visit to the new RWTH FAQ is also worthwhile and will provide you with useful information and answers to general questions. The information websites of the Immigration Office and the International Office at RWTH are regularly updated so that you are well informed in advance.
