Typical topics are academic issues, exam anxiety, problems in your relationship, with your parents or flatmates and loneliness. Especially at night, when friends and family are not available, Nightline Aachen offers a chance to talk.

They are available every **Monday** and **Thursday** from **9PM** to **Midnight** under the German landline **0241-56520343**.

Nightline Aachen is a group of student volunteers. They had training in phone conversations but are no experts or psychologists. They rather offer a talk with someone who can relate to your situation. You can call about anything on your mind, be it positive or negative. Speaking English is also welcome.

The "International Student Support Group Aachen" consists of young international people involved in providing a group for mental health problems.
