New mentees arriving soon

The new winter term 2023/2024 is about to start. A new exciting phase, especially for all our new international freshmen! Many of them will sign up for the BeBuddy program as a mentee, soon waiting to be matched with a Buddy. If you are interested in supporting a new international student (or more than one) and you are mostly on site in Aachen, please update your Buddy profile in the database so we can match you with a mentee. You can also write us an email to: bebuddy@rwth-aachen.de with your dates of availability and the amount of mentees you would like to support. Of course, being trained as a buddy is a prerequisite for that.

Next to becoming friends with your mentees, you will also have the opportunity to get to know other buddies during our Kick Off Buddy meeting by the beginning of the winter term and you'll receive a certificate for your buddy activity which also serves as a component for the Certificate International.

Also, if you have friends who would also like to become active as a buddy, please spread the word. We are always looking for new buddies © (especially faculty 3 and 6 are needed).

The only thing they have to do is to pass the <u>virtual BeBuddy training</u>. Being at least in the 2nd semester and **German language skills on a B1 level are obligatory**. 2) My home is your castle – Sublet your room to an international student

You are studying at RWTH and are planning to spend some time abroad soon? Sublet your place to an international student! My Home is your Castle was initiated by the International Office to make the outgoings' return easier for them after their stay abroad while also fostering contact between local and international students at the same time.

How does it work? Register your available apartment or room with our International Office Housing Advice Service Team (housing@rwth-aachen.de). We will pass your offer onto international students seeking for lodging. Ideally, you will find a suitable subtenant who will be studying at RWTH for exactly the period of time you will be gone. If you successfully sublet your place to an international student, you may even have it recognized as a component of Certificate International!
