## 1) Get nominated for the DAAD Prize 2022 for International RWTH Students

The DAAD Prize awards academically excellent international students and PhD candidates for their social and intercultural engagement. Students cannot apply for the prize themselves; they have to be nominated by

- RWTH Aachen University faculties
- university organizations
- RWTH student associations
- the student union AStA

The nominees should primarily live in Germany, show good academic achievements and be voluntarily active. The deadline for nominations is <u>June 15th 2022</u>, all nominations should be directed to <u>chiara.weber@zhv.rwth-aachen.de</u>

## 2) Tenancy law in Germany: information event for students (DE)
