



THE SCOUT (Working Title)

Yonsei is one of Korea's top colleges and the scout for the University baseball team, Hochang, is feeling the pressure to recruit the nation's top high school prospect, pitcher Sun Dongryul. Sun lives in the city of Gwangju in the South Eastern part of Korea. Hochang arrives there hopeful, but finds another baseball scout from a rival top-ranked college also seeking to sign Sun. The race is on for the two scouts and in the end Hochang ends up signing Sun and also ends up meeting his first love out of nowhere. But this is Spring of 1980, a time of great social and political upheaval in Korea. Student demonstrators are locked in a violent struggle against the repressive government dictatorship, and Gwangju is the epicenter of the fight. In the happiest moment of his life, Hochang finds himself in the middle of the student uprising that will become the Gwangju massacre.

WOMEN'S TEAM HANDBALL (Working Title)

The Athens Olympics are approaching and Korea is looking for gold in every sport. Korean women in particular have done well in almost areas except for the ignored and looked down upon sport of Team Handball. Can this oddball group overcome their personal differences and hardships and somehow come together as a team? Inspired by the true story of the Korean Women's Handball Team that won the Silver Medal in the 2004 Athens Olympics.

THE BRIDGE AT NOGUNRI

The Korean war does not start well for the US. They are being routed by the North Koreans and despite

US reinforcements from Tokyo, the US army is making a hasty disorganized retreat to the southern-most

city of Pusan. On the path to Pusan is the village of Jogunri, near the village of Nogunri. The US Army

orders all the villagers out of Jogunri, warning them that the North Koreans are coming. Some 500 make

their way, children on their backs, leading ox carts laden with belongings. But word is circulating among

the US forces that Northern soldiers may be hiding among the civilian refugees. As the Jogunri villagers

approach Nogunri, an American airplane suddenly swoops in and strafes and bombs the civilians, killing

many. In the ensuing chaos, the US soldiers force the remaining 400 villagers into a cave under a bridge.

The US soldiers then open fire. In the end, only 25 manage to survive the massacre. This film is based on

real events and on the book, "The Bridge at Nogunri," written by the Pulitzer Prize winning journalist team

that broke the story in 2000.
