Kiron Open Higher Education (gGmbH) is a non-profit organization with a mission to remove barriers to access higher education for displaced people, asylum seekers, and refugees. Our goal is to empower young people through higher education degrees. After studying online for two years, Kiron students spend their third year of study at one of our partner universities and, through the cooperation with our partner schools, are able to earn an accredited university degree. As a growing social startup based in Berlin with regional chapters in Munich, Aachen, London, Paris, Brussels, Istanbul, and Boston, we are working hard on the realization of this concept. In October 2015, the first 1000 students began their online courses. With our core team of over 60 people as well as over 200 volunteers, and the cooperation of about 50 professors worldwide, we are driving the mission to give refugees around the world an opportunity to pursue their higher education careers.

Your opportunities and responsibilities at Kiron:

- Assist the existing team in the development of Kiron's Social Work core curriculum by refining module content and structure, and finding high quality MOOCs (Massive Open Online Course) which cover the specified Learning Outcomes
- Match Kiron modules and MOOCs with modules and courses at our partner universities for our Social Work study track to help Kiron achieve curriculum equivalence
- Maximize the probability that our students receive recognition, from partner universities, for their studies through your work on the matching process.
- Finalize this into a complete Learning Agreement that can be signed by our academic partners

- Currently enrolled in a Social Work related Master's Program
- Ability to do self-paced, autonomous work
- Care and rigor, excellent time management, responsibility and reachability
- Fluency in English (our primary working language) and at least a working knowledge of German is required
- Ideally based in Berlin
