- **Jobs:** Food & Beverage, Merchandise, Custodial, Lifeguards.
- Program Dates: June 28 to September 9, 2005 There is no flexibility in the program dates. You must arrive and depart on the exact dates stated in the job offer.
- You can **participate** if you are enrolled at an university (minimum 5th semester). You cannot apply if you are graduating. Minimum age is 18; any major is acceptable.
- **Pay rate:** \$6.25 per hour. Minimum of 30 hours per week is guaranteed.
- **Insurance:** You are required to provide your own health insurance for the duration of the program.
- **Relocation Assistance:** You are responsible for the costs of your round-trip flight
- **Housing:** Is provided by the Walt Disney World Co. at a cost of \$69 \$87 per week. Bedrooms are shared by two people.
- **Transportation:** To and from work locations and housing complexes is provided by the Walt Disney World Co.

A recruitment day in Germany will be held on June 13.

You need to provide at the recruitment session the following documents, if there are missing documents, you can't pass the interview due to the short notice:

- Cleared police report
- An identity photo

- copy of your valid passport (if you don't have a passport there's no point in coming to the recruitment)

- Accreditation letter from your school following the example attached
- excellent presentation
- CV

The departure for this summer program will be on June 28th until September 09th.You will have to pay for your own flight and visa process (80 Euro). Disney will provide the visa (800 Euro).
